

INVITATION TO BID

Excelsior Springs School District #40 Elkhorn Elementary Retention Pond

The Excelsior Springs School District #40 is comprised of: 1- Early Childhood Center, 3- Elementary Schools, 1- Middle School, 1- High School, and 1- Technical Center, including a total district enrollment of approximately 2,900 students.

The Excelsior Springs School District #40 is currently accepting bids for dredging and installing a riprap wall around the Elkhorn Elementary retention pond.

Vendors are asked to submit bids by 3:00 PM, Friday, February 28, 2020 to Excelsior Springs School District #40, 300 W. Broadway, Excelsior Springs, MO 64024 (Attn: Anthony Berry).

Bids must be sealed and plainly marked: "Elkhorn Elem. Retention Pond."

Summary: Excelsior Springs School District is taking bids on the improvement of the Elkhorn Elementary School Retention pond as follows: 1. Dredging and the disposal of retention pond sludge and dirt that discharges out of the pond (Note: You must be a licensed contractor that can pull work permits and collaborate with the Missouri Dept. of Natural Resources.) 2. Please include a bid for installing a riprap wall all the way around the inside perimeter of the pond to stop erosion.

Note: The Excelsior Springs #40 Board of Education reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Prices quoted shall be guaranteed for a period of ninety (90) days after the closing date of the proposal.
