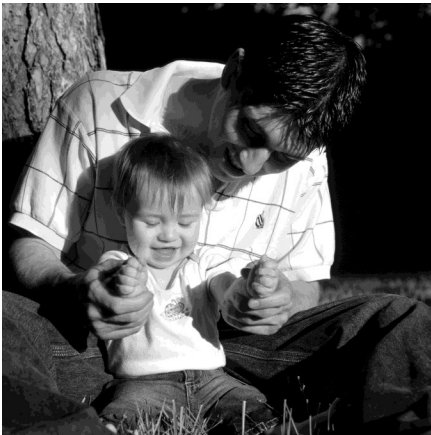

WHAT IS PARENTS AS TEACHERS?

The Excelsior Springs Schools Parents as Teachers program, or PAT, is part of a nationwide effort (implemented in every Missouri school district) to give parents the support and tools they need to be their children's best and most influential teachers in the crucial first five years. The developmental information that is shared at personal visits and group meetings is Parents as Teachers curriculum that is based on the latest information on brain research and child development information

We provide personal visits, where we will bring child development information based on the age of your child and the latest brain research. We'll show you age appropriate activities that you can do with your child

to help make the most of his first years.



We do yearly developmental screenings to give you the opportunity to see how your child is progressing.

Group meeting/playdates are held every Friday morning when school is in session. Meetings are parent/child activities and/or information for adult caregivers. They are usually held at the Early Childhood Center (the building that was formerly the vocational school.)
