Questions received from potential FSMC bidders:

- 1. Please provide the summer school labor schedule. We typically run one elementary and the middle school cafeteria for summer school. Approximately 15-20 days. Summer 2023 we ran 17 days. Same staffing for those schools for that amount of time/days.
- 2. In the Pre-bid conference, you mentioned a competitive minimum wage, please confirm the starting minimum wage you are requesting. We are attempting to raise the minimum wage for the district to \$14 or \$15 dollars. The FSMC should be willing to do the same.
- 3. Please confirm that all employees will maintain their current benefit coverage equal to or greater than their current coverage. Bids should ensure All employees should maintain their current benefit coverage equal to or greater than their current coverage.
- 4. Please confirm if the SFA will continue to provide the current CACFP dinner program for the school year 2024-25. Per the RFP, We will re-evaluate the utilization of CACFP at each eligible site each year.
- 5. **meal equivalent rate:** We are a non-severe need LEA that receives donated foods. Our meal equivalent rate will be \$4.79 for 2024-25.

- 6. Is the district billed additional costs outside of the meal rates, and if so, what are the charges for and the monthly amount? Ledgers have been run and placed into the google share folder that show all FSMC expenses/charges. Food Service Bank Accounts (20-21, 21-22, 22-23)
- 7. Does the district prefer to continue using disposables in place of washables in all buildings? We are open as long as any cost is transparent and clear in the RFP proposal. Per the RFP: FSMC should outline ANY additional fees and labor costs associated with start-up or transitioning to their FSMC should they win the contract. This should be outlined and clearly addressed within the bid proposal.
- 8. Please verify whether or not you currently have an Executive Chef. (It doesn't look like it but I've seen hourly "chefs" before.) Our High School Lead is also our district Chef has resume' chef experience prior to his position. This position Chef collaborates with the on-site district manager on menus and culinary training for staff and all team members. Also collaborates with the district manager on any/all catering.
- 9. How many paid sick days does each hourly employee receive?
 - 12 month employees receive 12 sick and 1 personal days
 - o 9 month employees receive 8 sick and 1 personal days
- 10. How many paid holidays does each hourly employee receive?
 - o Director or 12 month employee receives 22 holidays
 - o 9 month part time employees do not receive any holidays
 - o 9 month full time employees receive 14 holidays
- 11. How many hours are required each week for an employee to be considered full time?
 - o to be full time you must work 30 or more hours per week
- 12. Are benefits provided/covered by our existing FSMC (Aramark) during the summer months when employees are not working?
 - Part time do not receive any benefits
 - o Full time receive benefits all year

- 30. Are vending machines available to students/staff during breakfast and lunch serving times? NO
- 31. Is offer vs. serve in place at all schools? Yes
- 32. Is catering available? Yes, on a semi-limited basis. We cater school board meetings and principals are encouraged to utilize our FSMC for building activities.
- 33. Do you serve both breakfast and lunch on early release or late start days? YES
- 34. Do you have any contracts with laundry, chemical, or beverage suppliers? NO
- 35. Do you have any leases on equipment? (this is sometimes common for dishwashers)? NO
